Sacrament of Baptism

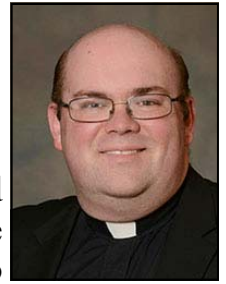

REVEREND JOHN R. EVANS, PASTOR



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peter went to Rome; Andrew to Russia and Scotland; one James stayed in Jerusalem; the other went to Spain, and so on. The Apostles divided the known world among themselves, and each one brought the Apostles' Creed to his allotted region.

St. Thomas went further east, so we always said, "He went to India!" We said it, but until St. Francis Xavier (d. 1552), we did not know it. When St. Francis Xavier landed in India, he met fellow Christians! They called themselves, "Thomas Christians," just like us! We too are "Thomas Christians."

The locals told St. Francis that St. Thomas spread the gospel among them, and ordained bishops and priests to succeed him in caring for their souls. The reigning Indian Emperor (Chola dynasty) was incensed at his teaching, so he had him stoned. How many people survive stoning? Well, since that did not work, the Emperor had him stabbed to death with multiple lances, which is why, in our adoration chapel, our Saint is depicted holding a lance. The earliest records indicate that he went to heaven on July 3rd. Thus, our feast day is this week!

I always thought it was sad that our patron saint is called Doubting Thomas. As the early Christians used to say, his doubt did so much for our faith! And he did so much good for Christ and His Church, that it seems unfair that we just remember that one mistake. And let's be honest, how many of us would have said the same thing?

But notice how much our Lord wants us to have faith in Him! He's willing to let a man poke at a scab, literally touch His Heart. We do the exact same thing, each time we make an act of faith. How awesome is that! Know that I remain

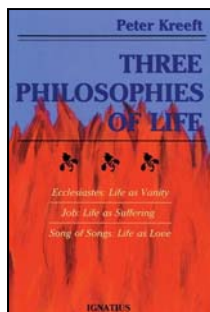

In *Three Philosophies of Life*, Kreeft reflects that there are ultimately only three philosophies of life and each one is represented by one of these books of the Bible—life is vanity; life is suffering; life is love. In these three books Kreeft shows how we have Dante's great epic *The Divine Comedy* played out, from Hell to Purgatory to Heaven. But it is an epic played out in our hearts and lives, here and now. Just as there is movement in Dante's epic, so there is movement in these books, from Ecclesiastes to Job, from Job to Song of Songs. Love is the final answer to Ecclesiastes' quest, the alternative to vanity, and the true meaning of life. Come hear Fr. Koutnik discuss these three philosophies.
